

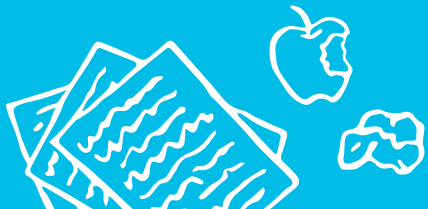
ENTRIES CLOSE @ 5PM ON 17 AUGUST 2019

- My entry is solely my own words
- I edited my own work
- I have only submitted one entry (as only one entry can be submitted)
- I have not copied my ideas from film, television or books
- My entry is no more than 2000 words
- My entry is handwritten or typed (if typed must be done by the entrant alone)
- My entry is accompanied by a completed entry form

ABOUT THE AWARD

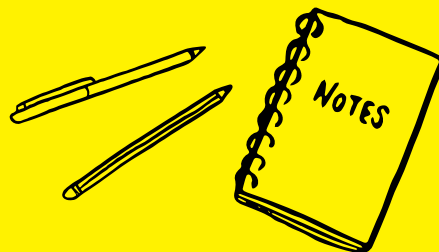
The Wangaratta Young Writers Award is run by the Rotary Club of Wangaratta and supported by the Rural City of Wangaratta.
